

COUNCIL FOR CLEAN AND RELIABLE ELECTRICITY WELCOMES ONTARIO'S AUDITOR GENERAL TO CONFERENCE ON SMART GOVERNANCE FOR SMART ELECTRICITY

Toronto, Ontario – Council for Clean and Reliable Electricity (CCRE) announced today that Ontario's Auditor General will be the key note speaker at their April 12th conference on the future of governance in Ontario's electricity sector. The CCRE is a forum for reasoned analysis on subjects related to electricity policy. In the past the Council has sponsored conferences on clean coal technology, nuclear power, governance models in the electricity sector and biomass energy opportunities.

The April 12th conference is intended to stimulate debate on the best governance approach in Ontario's evolving electricity sector. Auditor General Jim McCarter will outline concerns about Ontario's renewable energy programs identified in his 2011 report. He will answer audience questions and expert panels will then present and lead discussions of policy options and political considerations.

This conference is hosted by the University of Waterloo and the Richard Ivey School of Business at the University of Western Ontario in partnership with CCRE. The April 12th conference will be held 10am to 2pm at the Sheraton Centre Hotel in Toronto.
